

Additional Things You Should Know

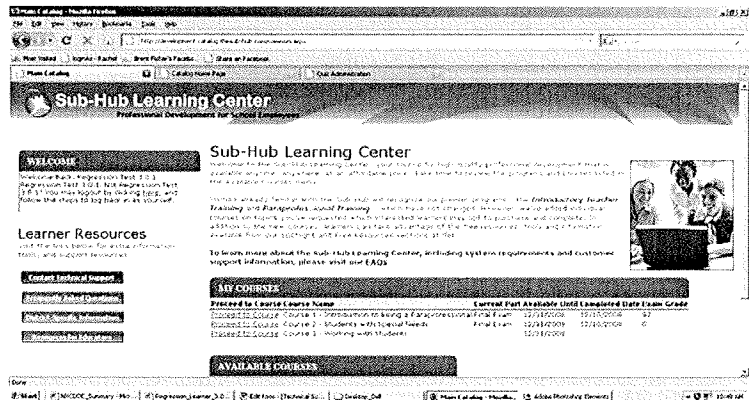
